CONDITIONS AND COMPETITION RULES

Accommodation & meals during the tournament (max. 13 boxers + 2 coaches + 1 medical)

In single room 120 €/person/day In twin room 80 €/person/day

o In triple room 70 €/person/day (2 beds + extra bed for an adult from the sofa)

Accommodation & meals during the tournament for one R&J

o In single room 90 €/person/day

In twin room free

• Accommodation & meals during the tournament for additional persons

In single roomIn twin room130 €/person/day100€/person/day

Prices include breakfast, lunch, and dinner from Thursday evening dinner until Monday breakfast.

Accommodation & meals for teams arriving before the 23rd or leaving after the 27th of November.

In single room
 In twin or triple room
 130 €/person/day with breakfast only
 100€/person/day with breakfast only

No other meals than breakfast is provided for teams with early arrival or late departure. The price is valid for the extra nights, otherwise the regular prices.

- The LOC provides:
 - o transportation from/to Tampere airport (TMP), railway/bus station upon arrival/departure for free
 - o transportation from /to Helsinki airport (HKI) upon arrival/departure <u>for an extra fee of</u> **80**€/person/return trip.
 - o local transportation during the tournament between the hotel and the venue
 - training facilities
 - o tournament awards (gold, silver, bronze medals, special awards, gifts for 1st and 2nd place)
- All team members must have private medical insurance. European boxers must have the European
 Health Insurance Card with them in case of medical services needed. The organizer does not provide
 medical insurance.
- Travel costs to Tampere and back home are the responsibility of the participating team.



All teams must pay the accommodation fee by bank transfer in advance. Team Delegations will not be able to receive accreditation cards and hotel rooms before the payment has been fully made. Only in special circumstances the payment can be done upon arrival by card or cash in EURO – in this case it must be agreed separately in advance with the LOC.

All enrolling National federations must pay a non-refundable accommodation & meals deposit of 25% (according to the final entry) no later than a week after the final entry date via a bank transfer.

COMPOSITION OF THE OFFICIAL DELEGATION

- Each participating federation may bring one boxer in each weight category. If any NF wishes to bring two boxers per weight category, this needs prior agreement from the LOC.
- Official delegation: max. 13 boxers, 2 coaches, 1 medical doctor and one Referee&Judge.
- Teams with less than 3 boxers, may not include more officials than boxers.
- Each participating team should bring include a Referee&Judge in their delegation. For teams with three or more boxers, Referee&Judge is mandatory.
- Additional people outside the official delegation are charged extra fee for their accommodation.
- Teams that arrive prior to the official arrival date or leave after the official departure date are charged extra fee for their accommodation.

COMPETITION RULES

- The tournament will be carried out in 7 men and 6 women elite Olympic weight categories:
 - Men 51kg, 57kg, 63.5kg, 71kg, 80kg, 92kg and +92kg.
 - o **Women** 50kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 66kg, 75kg.
- The participants must have equipment according to the Paris 2024 Boxing Unit Regulations.
 - Two sets of uniform, shoes, gumshield, protector (men)
 - Passport
 - Record book with up-to-date medical examinations and Medical Certificate
- LOC will provide STING boxing gloves and headguards (women) to all Boxers for all Bouts. Each
 participating Boxer must bring their personal Velcro bandages. Professional hand wraps will not be
 allowed.
- Bouts consists of 3 rounds, 3 minutes each. 10 Point Must-Scoring System will be used.
- Delegations can participate in the tournament only by fulfilling the conditions set in this invitation.



TRAVELLING TO TAMPERE

Tampere is easy to reach by plane or from Helsinki airport, train station or harbour.

Tampere-Pirkkala airport (TMP) is situated only 20km from the tournament hotel and the city centre. Recently renovated airport has opened multiple new connections and serves as a new base for AirBaltic. Also, Ryanair have connections to Tampere. Connections (subject to change):

Ryanair: From London - England (Stansted STN)

AirBaltic: From Amsterdam - The Netherlands (AMS), from Riga - Latvia (RIX),

Copenhagen - Denmark (CPH), Munich - Germany (MUC) Malaga - Spain (AGP)

and Milan -Italy (MXP)

Travelling to Tampere by ferry from Stockholm (Sweden) or Tallinn (Estonia):

From Stockholm: Ferry by Viking Line or Tallink/Silja Line to Helsinki or Turku and then by own

car, train, or bus to Tampere

From Tallinn: Ferry by Viking Line, Eckerö Line or Tallink/Silja Line to Helsinki and then by

own car, train, or bus to Tampere

Travelling to Tampere by train or bus from Helsinki airport (HEL) or Helsinki city center:

Train from Helsinki-Vantaa (HEL) airport Train or a bus from Helsinki city center

Both arriving to Tampere city center. It is very convenient, and the journey takes 1,5-3 hours depending on the time of the day and whether travelling by train or by bus.

Prices: Bus approximately 24 € / person / one way (booking online)

Train 9 – 33 € / person / one way (booking online)

Note! You can also book a transportation between Helsinki airport and Tampere from the LOC for the price of 80€/return trip.
